RATE OF PLAY: each player 25 mins + 5 sec/move increment from the start

BYE: players may request a First Round ½ point bye at time of entry

REFRESHMENTS: licensed bar on site; there is a Co-op next to the venue

RATINGS

ECF ratings from January 2026 will be used where available. RP ratings will take precedence over LP. Ratings used will be subject to the discretion of the organizers.

Rating history may be used to place a player in a higher section.

UNRATED PLAYERS must give details of their strength, previous results and any previous rating. Except in the Open section, they may only win one half of the first or second place prize. All other prizes will be paid in full.

PRIZES

Trophies will be awarded at the prizegiving ceremony held shortly after the final round. Cash prizes will be paid by bank transfer after the event wherever possible. Prizes paid by cheque and posted out may have P&P deducted.

Players eligible for multiple prizes can win no more than the higher-value prize.

A VETERAN PRIZE will be awarded to the highest scoring **65yr-and-over** player in the whole tournament.

JUNIOR & ADDITIONAL RATING PRIZES will be awarded according to age and number of entrants.

STOCKPORT LEAGUE TROPHIES

The highest scoring Stockport League registered player in the Major, Intermediate and Minor sections will be awarded an individual trophy.

CHESS ESSENTIALS will be selling DGT clocks, chess books, scoresheets, boards and sets, etc.

TRAVEL

The **GUILDHALL** is on the **A6 (Wellington Road South: SK1 3UA)** less than **1 mile south** of Stockport Town Centre.

By car it is 5 minutes from Junction 1 of the M60 Motorway.

There is a large **supervised** car park at the rear of the Guildhall, entrance on **Brentnall Street** (£3 per car payable on entry).

Stockport Rail and Bus stations are ½ mile walk up the A6 (10-15 minutes); **Davenport Rail** station is less than one mile walk (20-25 minutes) [or by bus 378A].

Frequent 192 bus service along the A6 from Central Manchester (stops outside venue).
